2024 Scored Illinois Legislation

Ownership of Dangerous Wild Animals (HB 4446)

A ✓ indicates a vote in favor of HB 4446, which prohibits the private possession of certain dangerous wild animals including servals, caracals, kangaroos, wallabies, and hybrids thereof. When these animals escape, they endanger both the public and law enforcement officials.

Sponsor: Rep. Daniel Didech (D)

Status: Passed the House

Wildlife Killing Contests Ban (HB 2900)

A ✓ indicates a vote in favor of HB 2900, which prohibits wildlife killing contests in the state of Illinois. Killing contests are organized events in which participants compete for prizes—typically cash and guns—for killing the most, the smallest, or the largest animals within a certain time period.

Sponsor: Rep. Anna Moeller (D)

Status: Passed the House
